NOTE

New regulations concerning the validity and use of certificates in the Public Administration came into force on 1 January 2012.

In compliance with the new regulation, the Public Administration cannot accept or request certificates concerning information which is already in the possession of the Italian public administration; only self-certifications will be accepted.

This does not apply to certificates which contain information which is not in the possession of the Italian public administration (e.g. "dichiarazione di valore" (declaration of value) for degrees obtained abroad).

ARTICLE 1 – Master general information and admission requirements

Under the terms of Decree no. 270 of 22 October 2012 issued by the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research, the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Modena e Reggio Emilia, Engineering Department "Enzo Ferrari", will run a **2nd level Master's degree programme**, in "**HIGH PERFORMANCE ENGINES**" for the academic year 2013-2014. The programme lasts for one year (full time attendance) and is delivered in English. The programme awards 60 learning credits (CFU).

2. **Written test and individual interview (with final score) .**

The maximum score (point 2) awarded by the Admission Board is 100 points, 30 of which are allocated to the assessment of the candidates' qualifications , 30 allocated to the written test and the remaining 40 are allocated to the individual interview.

In case of equal merit and qualifications the younger candidate will be chosen.

First 12 admitted will pass the selection and could apply for registration

The Admission is appointed by the Scientific Board; the person in charge of the selection procedure is the Director of the Master's degree programme;.

The selection processes will take place at Engineering Department " Enzo Ferrari" , Strada Vignolesse 905- Modena - the 24th and 25th of February 2014 at 9:00.

Any candidates residing or staying abroad, who are unable to attend the admission exam at the times and in the methods indicated above shall provide prompt written motivation to the Director of the Master, contacting the Director of the Master's degree program who may decide to carry out the selection using alternative methods to those described above.

ARTICLE 2 – Admission requirements

The programme is reserved for candidates who, at the time of closure of applications (30/01/2014) are in possession of the following qualifications and access requirements:

- a) 2nd level degree or degree under the previous system obtained in Italy;
- b) degree obtained abroad deemed appropriate by the Admissions Board, solely for the purposes of admission to the Master's Programme, equivalent to that listed in point a) of this article.

Further requirements:

- c) Certified knowledge of the English language;

Candidates who have a foreign qualification must provide the documents useful for verification (degree certificate with exams, or description of the degree with a list of exams, if necessary using the facsimile Annex B) to the Engineering Department "Enzo Ferrari" (Strada Vignolese 905 – 41125 Modena), attaching the document to the application form with the procedure described in art. 3.

Candidates possessing a degree obtained abroad should obtain the following documents from the Italian Diplomatic Representation in the country the degree was obtained:

- a) an authenticated copy of their qualification;
- b) the legalisation of the translated degree certificate;
- c) the "dichiarazione di valore" (declaration of value).

ARTICLE 4 – Production and approval of the list of qualified candidates

At the end of the selection process, the commission will draw up the list of qualified candidates, drawn up on the basis of the total score awarded.

Enrollment in a Master is incompatible with enrollment in other courses, undergraduate, graduate postgraduate course, doctoral research, internship active (TFA) and another master's degree.

ARTICLE 5 – Enrollment: payment of the first instalment and delivery of documents

ARTICLE 7 – Class attendance

Class attendance is mandatory and the minimum requirements for Master title are:

- Frequency for a period of not less than 70% of the total duration of the in class lessons;
- The frequency for a period of not less than 70% of the total duration of the training;
- Passing all the sets of the intermediate tests;
- Passing the final exam.

ARTICLE 8- Credits and title

Master's Degree in art. 1 gives 60 credits as art. 7, paragraph 4 of D.M.270/2004.

At the end of the course, after passing the final exam will be awarded the title of University Master's Degree in "HIGH PERFORMANCE ENGINES"

The award of the title is subordinate to the correct payment of tuition and fees and any surcharges.

ARTICLE 9 – Privacy

The University Administration, in accordance with Legislative Decree 196/2003, is committed to use the personal data provided by the candidate only for the completion of the selection procedure and for institutional reasons.
